## V. Review of Recent Events

## A) Organization

- **1.** Brad reported it will take up to 180 days to hear back on our non-profit, tax exempt status. We will need to file a 990-N.
- 2. Set up gas account at River Country. They will fill up harvester when needed.

#### B) Harvester

- 1. Purchase Will receive conveyor estimates from Inland and Aquarius for galvanized conveyor to replace belt #1 and #2. Will need to replace conveyor belt #3 soon. Add conveyor costs to grant.
- 2. Repairs -
  - Brackets for walkway are being installed tonight. Build a walkway on harvester.
  - Mount the GPS unit with a lockbox. Install keyless entry to hold key.
  - Wheel bearings need replaced; Mike will talk with Day's about bearings.
  - Winch has worn out; Mike will install new one.

## 3. Safety

- Navigational lighting will not be installed right now. Not using harvester after dark.
- Sean discussed how to mark out fish cribs using the GPS.
- **4.** Registration Not needed

### C) Lake Rehabilitation Plan

1. Grants – We have until 2023 to satisfy requirements of grant.

- Gretchen discussed a Healthy Lakes Grant, which BCLA may be eligible to apply for. Possible reimbursement for shore buffers, rain garden and native plant installation. May deadline.
- Will need to ask for another \$5,000 donation from the City after January 1st in order to meet grant application needs.
- 2. Volunteers We need volunteers now.
  - Pumping at Martin Bridge. Need 6-7 guys.
  - Harvesting to start as soon as we can.
  - Post Annual Meeting Notice in paper to try recruit volunteers and members.
  - Discussion of hiring someone to help truck weeds, if no volunteers.
- **3.** Boom Beach booms measured for purchase of booms. 1-100' and 1-50' boom from Elastec \$3,066.85 (this was a 5% increase from last quote). Street department will install booms. Put ad in paper when booms are installed.
